#### Treasurers Report: Tim Davidson:

Geoff Hasler moved that Steve Wilson be authorised to spend up to \$5/metre, up to \$600 across three pitches, seconded by Barry McDonald, PASSED.

#### • Bank Balances.

The current cash position is a positive balance of \$153,942 as well as having a term deposit of \$65,000. The term deposit represents the balance of the Ground Maintenance Fund. This balance is after the collection of season 2013/14 fees from all Clubs and the payment of all season ground hire charges with the exception of Kenthurst No1 for 2012/13 and 2013/14.

#### Ball Rebates.

We have now received our rebate from Kookaburra for the period 1 April 2013 to 31
 December 2013 which totalled \$6,630 ex GST. Thank you to the Clubs that have already sent through their invoices and I will be distributing the rebates next week so please get your invoices in. I have received invoices from Normanhurst, Hornsby, Mt Colah, Beecroft, Berowra, Kissing Point and Sydney Lions.

#### **HKHDCUA (Umpires) Report:** Geoff Hasler (Steve Wilson absent):

- Firstly, may I remind clubs with teams in A and Kookaburra Cup grades to have the team Captains submit their Umpire Reports and ground Reports for every match.
  - o Steve is currently chasing up the missing reports and there are penalties for repeat offenders.
  - o A Grade: Rd 10 Hornsby, Berowra, Kenthurst, Rd 12 Hornsby
  - Kooka Cup: Rd 10: Berowra, WPHC, Rd 11: Hornsby, Rd 12: Hornsby, Sydney Lions.

#### Finals/Semi Finals Etc;

- It is our intention to have two umpires at each and every Semi and Final, however, to accomplish this we do require additional personnel to assist, BUT, we do insist that the minimum qualification is a current Captains Ticket.
- Please take this message back to your teams, specifically those with limited if any chance of playing in the finals, to register their interest with the Umpires Secretary at hornsbyumpires@outlook.com
- Steve will be sending a similar request out through the clubs, but often this never gets to the appropriate individuals.
- Given that we have some 20 + NSWCUSA qualified umpires within our ranks, we are hopeful that the majority of these people will be available, however, some will still be engaged in the finals.

#### OVER RATES:

- Clubs are now on notice that the umpires will be taking an increased interest in the over rates, as we are unimpressed by the over rates of a number of A AND Kookaburra Cup teams, with some matches going until 6.45 or later.
- Umpires will be reminded to inform the captains on an hourly basis of their over rate progress and will seek their cooperation in increasing the tempo of the changes between overs, where time can be saved.
- The umpires Association will be drafting a rule change for consideration next season for penalties to be incurred for slow over rates.
- A minimum of 15 per hour is surely the basis of a reasonable rate of play, and this is rarely achieved by many teams, although, some captains achieve this, and better, as a standard.

#### SCOREBOOKS:

- The standard of scoring in the higher grades is not as it should be, with discrepancies being encountered more often than not.
- Please send a strong message to your captains to ensure that those entrusted with scoring are numerate, are attentive to their role, AND FINISH THE JOB.





- Too often, the final scores are not totalled, sundries are not totalled, not out batsmen are not totalled and batting and bowling do not agree.
- Perhaps we need to incorporate a scoring responsibility into the captain's accountabilities. It
  is important that the scores and results are signed off by the captains at the conclusion of the
  game and at the end of play on Day 1.

## HKHDCCA (Coaches) Report: Bruce Wood:
